LEAD-IN-WATER ANNUAL NOTICE 2023-24



Minnesota Statute 121A.335 requires public school buildings serving kindergarten through grade 12 to test for lead in water every 5 years. This statute also requires school districts to make the results of the testing available to the public for review and to notify parents of the availability of the information. Notification may be accomplished by publishing a statement in a "Back to School" newsletter or publication on the district website that is available to staff, students, parents and the public.

Faribault Public Schools is committed to providing a safe working and learning environment for employees and students. The District has developed a Lead in Water (LIW) Management Plan and testing program that complies with Minnesota Statute 121A.335, as well as recommendations from the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Lead Contamination Control Act (LCCA) of 1988 and the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), and Minnesota Department of Education (MDE).
